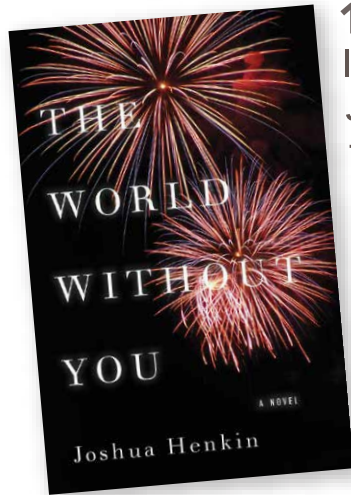


SIBLING RIVALRIES AND MARITAL FEUDS
